- 3. Failure to properly register for your junior or senior recital by the end of add/drop will necessitate the rescheduling of your senior recital to a subsequent semester and may delay your graduation.
- 4. **ALL** music performed must be approved by the student's applied instructor. Music performed that has not been approved by the applied instructor will result in a grade of Unsatisfactory (U) and will require the student to repeat the senior recital requirement.
- 5. This form needs to be returned to the Music Office no later than one week following the recital hearing.
