
Degree Works Student Guide

Students may view Degree Works by logging into Banner and selecting Degree Works on the Main Menu. Listed below are the various components (blocks) of a Degree Works student audit. Please select the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) button for more detailed information and refer to the Legend below for a description of the symbols. The "*" symbol next to a course means the course has a prerequisite <u>listed in the catalog</u>.



1. Student Information block

a. Catalog Year is very important as it determines unique requirements for each degree program.



2. Degree Progress bar

a. This is an approximation since all requirements are weighted equally although some may take more time to complete.




